Arrival & Departure	:	Participants are expected to arrive on Thursday, 17 <sup>th</sup> March and departure Monday, 21 <sup>st</sup> March thereafter.
Eligibility	:	Ventures, Rovers and non-Scouts (17 – 26 years old).
Programme	:	The Discovery Workshop aims to expose young people to the global issues that our Earth and Country are facing – to <b>Explore, Respond and Take Action</b> . Besides raising awareness of our rich natural heritage and community, the workshop also seeks to equip the youth with development, facilitation and planning skills in preparation for the next phase – the Voluntary Service Project.


