



BINB Scout Peace Camp



Bangladesh Scouts will organize a Scout Peace Camp with participation of Bangladesh, India, Nepal & Bhutan (BINB) on 5-8 May 2016 in Burimari, Lalmonirhat, Bangladesh. 4 patrols from each country (each patrol consisting of 9 members) will attend this Scout Camp. Basic information of the camp follows:

Aim : The aim of BINB Scout Peace Camp is to promote peace, progress, friendship and culture.

Objectives :

- To provide a platform for the youth of the four countries to understand one other and develop their relation to friendship.
- To foster regional cooperation and development.
- To enlarge the Messenger of Peace (MoP) network.
- To share and exchange these four countries' culture.

Theme : **Scouting for Peace & Friendship.**

Date : 5-8 May 2016. Participants are requested to arrive on 5th May 2016 before 04.00 pm and may leave on 8th May 2016 at 08.00 am.

Venue : Burimari, Lalmonirhat, Bangladesh

Eligibility : Scouts (boys & girls): Age between 14 to 17 years;
Leaders (male & female): Age 26+

No. of participant : Total 36 members from each country.
16 (boys) + 2 (Male Leaders) = 18
16 (girls) + 2 (Female Leaders) = 18

Registration Fee : US \$ 50.00 (Fifty) for each foreign participant.

Detail of the Programme :

- **Opening Ceremony:** An attractive opening ceremony will be arranged.
- **Interactive Games :** The 1st event is an interactive game. Actually it is ice-breaking for all the participants. By the end of the game, the participants will be friends and start forming mixed groups which will continue till the last day of the camp.
- **Friendship Activity :** Each participant will be provided with a small part of a country map (Bangladesh/India/Nepal/Bhutan). Each country map will have 36 parts. The participants have to complete a country map. The group which will be able to do it earlier, they will be winner and get an exclusive gift from the camp authority.
- **MoP Activity :** There will be some "Messenger of Peace" activities, such as writing, drawing, networking game, etc. related with Peace.
- **Youth Forum :** Youth Forum will be conducted to share the ideas to promote and develop the relation of the participating NSOs. There will be four groups consisting of 8 members from each country. And the other participants will prepare recommendation for this camp.
- **Food Festival & Cultural Presentation :** Each country will exhibit their cultural and traditional dress, food, handicrafts, heritages and scouting activities in the country. At the end of the day, they may gift, exchange or sell this item. Participants may bring musical instrument if necessary.
- **Discovery :** Scouts will get opportunity to visit local rural area nearby their campsite. They may exchange their ideas and views to the rural people and get experience from their livelihood. They will get opportunity for swimming, fishing, kiting, horse riding, backwoodsman cooking, climbing, etc.
- **Sight-seeing:** Participants will enjoy the scenic beauty and important places close to the campsite. It will be a half day tour.
- **International Night :** Some selected performances from cultural activity and some local performances will be presented here.
- **Food and Accommodation:** The participants will be provided cooked food. They will be accommodated in tents. Tents will be provided by the host organization.

Things bring

to : Participants are requested to bring Scout uniform, NSO flag (2), National Flag, CD of National Anthem, Sleeping bag, personal toiletries, shorts, rain coat, cades, personal medicine, torch, flashlight and other necessary belongings as deemed fit for the camp. Each contingent is requested to bring First-Aid Kit, Materials for Exhibition, traditional food, handicrafts, traditional dress for Food Festival and Cultural presentation.

Entry Visa : Bangladesh Scouts will provide visa request letter to the respective High Commission/Embassy for Entry Visa. Therefore, each NSO is requested to provide passport details of the participants **within 31st March 2016.**

The overseas participants are requested to send nomination along with their passport details to the below mentioned address **on or before 31st March 2016.**
